Check-in

The conference starts with a plenary session which takes place on Thursday January 17, at 15:00. Before that time the participants should have made their check-in at the conference hotel. Check-in takes place between 14:00 and 15:00.

Common arrival from Aalborg Airport

On arrival day DRUID will arrange bus transport from Aalborg Airport to the conference site in Rebild. The most suitable flight is the 12:55 domestic flight departure from Copenhagen Airport (Kastrup). This flight arrives at Aalborg Airport 13:45, and the bus will leave around 14:00. On arrival day DRUID also will arrange bus transport from Skoerping Railway Station to the conference site. The most suitable train is the 10:00 departure from Copenhagen (Kastrup 9:40). The train arrives at Skoerping 14:22.

Departure with bus for Aalborg Airport

The conference ends Saturday January 19, at 15:00. International participants will normally stay until Sunday (to obtain APEX fares) either at the conference site or in Copenhagen. There will be common transport to Skoerping Railway Station Saturday at 15:20 organised for the train departing from Skoerping 15:47 and Aalborg Airport oganised for the flight departing from Aalborg at 17:40.

The PhD students who are going to participate in the Ph.D-course at Copenhagen Business School (Monday 21 to Friday 25 of January) are expected to make their own hotel reservations. Papers to be presented by PhD studentents and senior researchers will be made available for <u>downloading</u>. You will NOT get paper versions in conference volumes at the arrival at the conference site.

Introductory note to the programme

The programme will consist of 6 keynote adresses presented by seniors and approximately 40 PhD presentations which have now been selected. The PhD presentation will be organised in a series of 3 parallel sessions. Each paper will be given 40 minutes: 15 minutes for the presentation, 5 min. for the junior discussant, 5 minutes for the senior discussant and 15 minutes for general discussion and answers from the PhD student. We will allocate all the discussants (juniors and seniors) at the latest when we have all the papers available at January 3rd. The detailed programme will be put on the conference web site at Monday January 7th at the latest.

The general theme for the keynote adresses is 'Industry Evolution and Analysis'. Given the papers the authors have been asked to broaden their perspective and relate their contributions to various alternative approaches and methodologies in industry analysis.

Francesco Lissoni or Stefano Breschi, CESPRI, Bocconi University: 'Network of inventors and the location of university research: an exploration of Italian data'. (Joint paper with Margherita Balconi)

Staffan Jacobsson, Industrial Dynamcis Group, Chalmers University, Gothenburg: Paper on the sustainable energy producing sector (precise title forthcoming)
